

# Onward students exhibit resiliency during the pandemic.



Onward has studied the impact of our program using some of the most rigorous research standards. One key finding we measure is how frequently Onward students graduate from high school on time and immediately enroll in college.

Students who started in Onward in middle school in 2014 and enrolled in college in 2021 were 40% more likely to achieve this key milestone of "graduating high school on time and immediately enroll in college" compared to their closely matched peers.

### 2012 - 2019

449 students started in Onward in 2012 and were

more likely to graduate from high school on time and immediately enroll in college (compared to their peers)

### 2013-2020

619 students started in Onward in 2013 and were

more likely to graduate from high school on time and immediately enroll in college (compared to their peers)

#### 2014-2021

591 students started in Onward in 2014 and were

more likely to graduate from high school on time and immediately enroll in college (compared to their peers)

## When you look more closely at the 2014-2021 cohort, a few characteristics stand out

of Onward males were more likely to graduate high school on time and immediately enroll in college (compared to their male peers) 400

of Black Onward students were more likely to graduate high school on time and immediately enroll in college (compared to their Black peers) 400

of Hispanic Onward students were more likely to graduate high school on time and immediately enroll in college (compared to their Hispanic peers)
